

Welcome to the Midland County Fairgrounds

Camping

Midland Fairgrounds has just over 400 campsites and is located at 6905 Eastman Avenue in Midland, Michigan 48642. There are modern bathhouses, electrical hookups and shared water sources throughout the campground. Most sites have 30 amp electrical services. Some sites are pull-through while others require backing the trailer into the campsite. A sanitation station is available for use at the main gate with a fee of \$10.00 (drop-box located at station), during the timeframe of mid-April to mid-October each year.

Pets

Pets are permitted in the campground and must be under your control at all times. All pets must be properly licensed and per city ordinance, be on a leash. Owners are responsible for pets' actions and proper disposal of pet waste. We welcome Service animals.

Camping Season and Rate

The campground opens in early May and will close in mid-October. The rate is \$20 per night.

Reserving a site and Checking-In

Please contact the Fair Office at 989-835-7901 for availability of camping depending on events at the facility. Reservations can be made using Mastercard, Visa, and Discover credit cards. The Fair Office is open from Monday through Friday, from 9:00a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Maximum Number of People Per Site: Site occupancy is limited to one family unit. Anyone renting a campsite must be 18 years of age or older and must be present at the campsite.

Alcoholic Beverages

Alcoholic beverages are allowed responsibly in the campgrounds at your campsite.

Fires

Fires are permitted only in approved containers up off the ground that have a lid. Fires must be attended at all times and extinguished before leaving the campsite.

We are located at Exit 122 from East or Westbound US-10. Follow the cityscape signs to the Fairgrounds.
