WHEN: Wednesday night of the
Midland County Fair
August 17, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

WHERE: Livestock Pavilion by
Cattle Barn. (Glover Arena)

WHAT: Rabbits, Goats, Cavies,
Ducks, Turkeys, Geese, Pigeons
and Honey. All are animals or
produce from 4-H Projects.

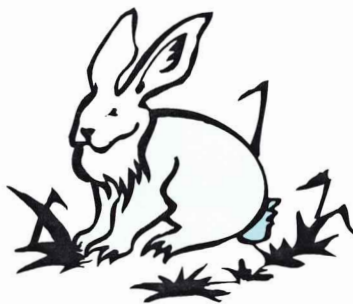
It is suggested buyers arrive by
6:00 p.m. to facilitate check-in
and reduce waiting time in line.



CHECK-IN PROCEDURE: All
buyers must register at the auction
clerk's table prior to bidding.

BIDDING: An auctioneer will
conduct the auction – all bids need
to be recognized by the auctioneer
to be valid.

PAYMENT: *All purchases must be
paid for the night of the auction.
Payment can be made by cash, check or
card. A 3.5% processing fee will be
applied to credit cards purchases.*



BUYERS OPTIONS:

- ✓ Buyer may keep item purchased.
- ✓ First buyer may send item
through again on resale* or
- ✓ Donate item back to 4-H
member.

***RESALE:** An original successful bidder
who does not wish to keep the auctioned
animal may submit the animal to be
auctioned for a second time. The
proceeds from the lowest bid of the
original or second sale of animal are
donated to the 4-H Small Animal
Committee and the money will be used
to improve the 4-H small animal exhibits.
The proceeds from the highest bid of the
original or second sale go to the 4-H
exhibitor (seller). The bidder on the resale
(second sale) of the animal is responsible
for the disposition of the animal.

TAX DEDUCTIBILITY: Any
purchase that is made above
market price for that week is a
donation and can be a write off
from your taxes.

PUBLICITY: A buyer that
purchases from the Small Animal
Auction will receive publicity
including recognition in a local
newspaper.

The Small Animal Leaders will
provide a dinner and water starting
at 6 p.m. for registered buyers.

BUYER'S RESPONSIBILITY:
Sunday 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. is when
auction items are to be picked up.
(The 4-H member must meet the
seller at the agreed time.) **Auction**
items may NOT be released
before 8:00 a.m. Sunday,
August 21, 2022

SELLER'S RESPONSIBILITY: If
animals are not picked up at the
fair it is up to the 4-H member to
deliver the animal within 30 miles.

Buyers from the 2021 Small Animal
Auction will receive a free Parking
Pass for the day of the auction.
