Show Fees:

- ~ Show accepts; Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express (valid ID required for credit payments, credit card processed through Square)
- ~ Camping Fees: \$25 per night, permits must be visible, window on or near the man door
- ~ No arrivals prior to Friday at 1pm (charges may apply)
- ~ Stall Fees: \$20 per day (Saturday/Sunday)
- ~ \$2.00 office fee will be charge for each entry of an exhibitor & horse combination per day
- ~ \$5.00 Entry Fee – Regular Classes (ribbons awarded 1-6)
- ~ \$10.00 Jackpot Classes Entry Fee – Pay-Back to top 3 only
Pay-Back for the top 3 are 50% to 1st / 25% to 2nd / 15% to 3rd
- ~ \$5.00 Speed Classes Entry Fee – Pay-Back to top 3 only
Pay-Back for the top 3 are 50% to 1st / 25% to 2nd / 15% to 3rd
- ~ \$2.00 for High Point consideration
- ~ There will be a \$25.00 fee assessed for all checks returned by the bank for any reason
- ~ No class entry fee refunds after 8am the day of show & no transfer of entry fees to another rider, horse or entry

General Show Rules:

- ~ Show uses the 4-H rules, the judge's decision is final
- ~ Helmet with straps securely fastened must be worn by riders participating in the warm up for jumping, the 3 jumping classes and Saturday's speed classes (A warm up jump will be set and maned during the afternoon, no other jumps are permitted on the grounds)
- ~ No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to show a stallion
- ~ Age of Exhibitor as of January 1, 2019 / Age of Horse as of December 31, 2019
- ~ Horses MUST have a current year negative Coggins Test & be present during registration
- ~ Horses must be stalled with bedding in stall, showing from a trailer is not permitted
- ~ Show committee has the discretion to combine classes with 3 or fewer entries
- ~ All dogs are to be leashed on grounds and not allowed in the barns or arenas
- ~ Back numbers will be supplied by the show committee
- ~ * May only participate in Pee-Wee classes, which are walk trot.
- ~ << Rider may only participate in Novice Rider classes and Halter
- ~ Classes that do not count for Daily High Point: (Classes are not eligible for Overall HP) 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 13, 15, 16, 17, 22, 28, 29, 35, 42, 43, 44, 45 & Saturday's Speed Classes
- ~ Classes that count for Daily High Point: (Daily HP classes are eligible for Overall HP) 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 18, 19, 20, 21, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40 & 41
- ~ High Point tallied throughout the day and points will be given by size of the class (e.g. a class with 9 exhibitors, 1st place will receive 6 points; a class with 4 exhibitors, 1st place will receive 4 points)
- ~ Overall Weekend High Point is for exhibitors who have entered for the Daily High Point (If not enter for a High Point on one of the days that day's points will not be considered of the overall).
- ~The exhibitor from the predetermined age groups with the highest accumulated points for the weekend will be awarded the Overall High Point.
- (2 Weekend Overall High Points will be awarded, one for 18 and under age groups and one for 19 and over age groups)
