

Todd W. Myers Citizenship Award

Todd Myers was a lifetime 4H member and then served as a 4H leader in Midland County. He died in 2008 at the age of 46. He was respected within the 4H organization and Midland community for his integrity, willingness to help anyone and commitment to agriculture. He was a role model for many.
